- A typed, single-spaced, one-page Personal Statement outlining the potential benefits of the award to your teaching and professional growth, and to your institution and community. This statement should address:
 - your interest in broadening your knowledge of China;
 - ways in which your teaching will be affected by the Institute
 - how you plan to use the experience to affect curricular change; and how you expect to contribute to the Institute.

Your application will not be considered if not completed with all items mentioned above.
