As usual, SEF International (SEFI) is sending you again updated information about our exciting teaching in China program - Teaching English while Learning Chinese (TELC). We have good news to share with you. Starting 2014, SEFI has started a new partnership with AASCU (The American Association of State Colleges and Universities) in the effort for recruiting for the TELC program.

TELC program offers an excellent job opportunity for recent college graduates and language teachers interested in the Chinese language and its culture. This is a paid ESL teaching position (teaching mainly oral English) with a minimum one-year commitment (renewable).

We would appreciate very much if you could forward this message and the attachments to the email list of your students, alumni or to other interested parties.

TELC participants teach English as a second language (mainly oral English) to elementary/secondary school students and adults in Shanghai, China, and its suburbs. The Shanghai Pacican Academy (Pacican), which hires the teachers, offers them free Chinese classes and activities/tours throughout their stay in China.

TELC benefits include:

- Competitive salary,
- Free Chinese lessons every week and some weekend cultural activities,
- Reimbursement of international airfare after completing the year's contract,
- End of year bonus,
- Commuter allowance,
- Assistance from a bi-lingual coordinator,
- Generous vacation time with allowance,
- Work insurance (Comprehensive Accidental Insurance),
- Foreign Expert Certificate (for work visa and high salary),
- Intensive orientation and job training ... and much more.

Minimum requirements for the position:

- The candidate should hold at least a bachelor's degree in any major;
- The candidate should be a native speaker of English (holding passports of an English speaking country);
- The candidate should have at least two years of teaching experience or a TESOL/TEFL Certificate (minimum 120-hour course from any reliable school-based or on-line organizations).

Please note:

- The two-year experience and TESOL certificate requirements can be waived if the candidate holds a master's degree or a Ph.D.
- Chinese language skills are preferred but not required.
- Applications are accepted on a rolling basis.
- The deadline for the TESOL/TEFL Certificate is May 31st for work visa application purpose.

With TELC program, our students are able to gain teaching and overseas experience, to learn the Chinese language, and to enjoy the Chinese culture all at the same time.
