



Case Competition Prize Overview

To be eligible for prizes, each team of 4-7 students must submit a **Final Case Solution by April 14th, 2023**. All students who submit their final case solution are automatically welcomed into the Up to Us Alumni Community and are eligible for prizes that enable continual learning and development as leaders (e.g. internships, online courses, and career opportunities).

Only students who are enrolled in a curricular or co-curricular opportunity led by a faculty member within the American Democracy Project's Civic Solutions cohort are eligible to participate. Faculty and staff must apply to this cohort by October 28th, 2022.

What will students gain from the program?

- Resume-building research experience
- Each course will receive \$300 to execute their final case solution
- Access to exclusive training materials and resources
- Access to the Up to Us Alumni Network

will win \$5,000

Teams 2-5

will each win \$1,000

- Students will be eligible to apply to Up to Us paid fellowship and internship programs, as well as course scholarships to Harvard Business School Online
- **One student from each of the top 5 teams will attend an all-expenses-paid professional development trip to the 2023 Civic Learning and Democratic Engagement Meeting in Boston, MA . Students will present their solutions at this conference.**
